

Shooting Sports

The rifle/pistol/archery range is open 7 days a week unless a special event is scheduled. On Saturdays Trap, Skeet, and 5-Stand Sporting Clays start at 9am and are done around 1:00pm. On Wednesdays the Trap and Skeet fields are open at 10:00am. Trap and skeet are \$4 per round, and Sporting Clays is \$5

Weekly trap practice on Monday and Sporting Clays on Thursday will resume in the Spring

Shooting hours are Monday to Saturday 8am, Sunday 10am, until 15 minutes before sunset. All shooting must stop 15 minutes before sunset.
