Instructions for New Members

Thank you for your interest in becoming a member of the Baldwinsville Rod & Gun Club. Since 1938, we have been committed to environmental conservation and the preservation of shooting sports and other outdoor skills. We are devoted to responsible stewardship of the local area for the future use of any interested outdoor enthusiast.

New members of the club must submit this form completely filled out to become a member. The form can be digitally filled and emailed, or printed and brought in. Please print legibly. If emailing, you may also include a portrait photo for your ID card. Otherwise, we will take your photo when you arrive. Only cash or check are accepted. Checks can be made out to the Baldwinsville Rod & Gun Club. After you become a member, you may mail in checks to renew your membership.

All new members must complete a short safety briefing and club orientation when applying. Applications are processed at the clubhouse on the schedule indicated on our website. <u>If you have any questions regarding our availability, please email us.</u> On busy days, we may ask that you wait while we process members so that we can give the briefing as a group. Please bring eye protection, hearing protection, and a valid driver's license with your current address.

A family membership includes the primary (paying) member and secondary members: his/her spouse, and any children age 12-17 who live in the same household. If the **secondary members** will be attending the Club without the primary member present, they **must also complete the orientation process.** Student memberships are for full-time students between ages 18-22.

All memberships cover calendar years. This is determined by the date you submit your application. If you are applying from January through the end of November, your membership will be good until December 31st of that year. If you are applying in October or November, your price will be lower but it will still only include the remainder of that calendar year. If you apply in December, your membership will cover the remainder of the year and the entire next year. Therefore, following-year membership sales begin December 1st.

After the orientation, you will be permitted to use the grounds as a full club member. Ensure that you wear eye and ear protection at all times when in a shooting area. **Note: no birdshot or buckshot is permitted on the rifle range.** When finished, fill out the EPA range lead report at the marked station. **Observe and follow all posted rules and steel target caliber restrictions.**

Shooting times are Monday-Saturday 8am until 15 minutes before sunset. On Sundays, shooting may begin at 10am.

The Baldwinsville Rod & Gun Club is run entirely by members who volunteer their time. If you notice the nets torn, targets left up, excessive brass on the range, or any other issue, please notify us or assist in helping us maintain the club grounds. Recurring maintenance that we are always in need of includes grass cutting, steel target repair, and membership committee assistance. If you would like to become more involved with club activities, we hold meetings at the clubhouse on the first Thursday of every month at 7pm.
